**Application Guidance**

**Applicant** – must be the owner or primary operator of the site or premises, and/or regulated products that will be the subject of the Alternative Safety Approach.

**Administrative Authorized Representative** – must be an employee of the applicant, with sufficient authority to ensure the effective administration of the Alternative Safety Approach such as a director or senior manager.

**Technical Authorized Representative** – this individual serves as the main technical contact and is generally responsible for the day to day administration of the Alternative Safety Approach.

**Details** – Either section (a) or (b) must be completed as a part of the Alternative Safety Approaches application:

- (a) For each section of regulation sought for exemption please provide the following information:
  1. the name of the regulation or code (i.e. Safety Standards General Regulation, Canadian Electrical Code, etc.);
  2. the specific clause number (i.e. 12, 19(a), etc.); and
  3. a brief description of what is being sought for exemption and the alternative approach proposed to be implemented.
- (b) Alternatively, a detailed description of the desired outcome you are attempting to achieve through an Alternative Safety Approach can be provided in section (b).
