Date of Issue: October 05, 2012

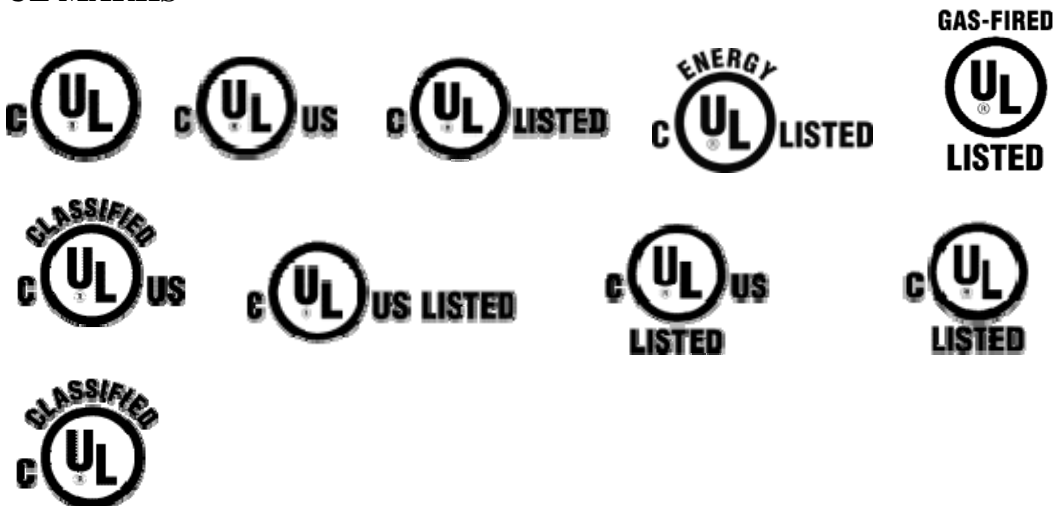
General Details

Under section 31 (1) of the Gas Safety Regulation, gas appliances must not be installed in BC unless they bear either a certification mark of an approved certification agency or an approval mark issued by the BC Safety Authority under section 10 of the *Safety Standards Act*. This Directive specifies the certification/approval marks that are acceptable in BC.

It is hereby directed that the following certification/approval marks are acceptable for gas appliances in BC:

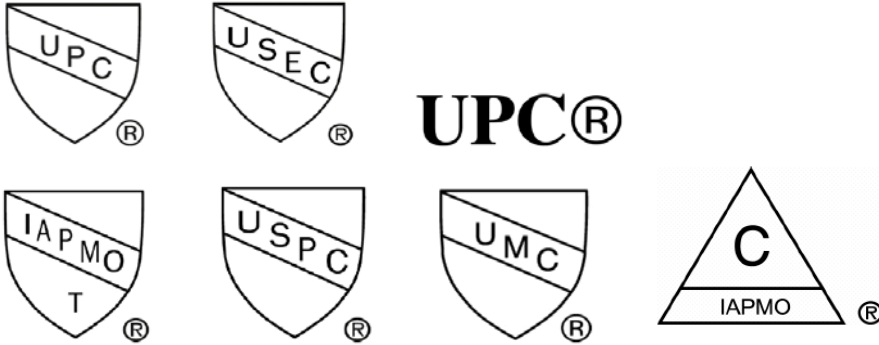
