

# ELECTRICAL FIELD SAFETY REPRESENTATIVE RENEWAL FEES CONSULTATION SUMMARY REPORT

From July 28 to September 13, 2017, BC Safety Authority consulted on a proposed \$100 fee for renewals of Electrical Field Safety Representative certificates of qualification. The proposed fee is part of planned changes to the FSR certification.

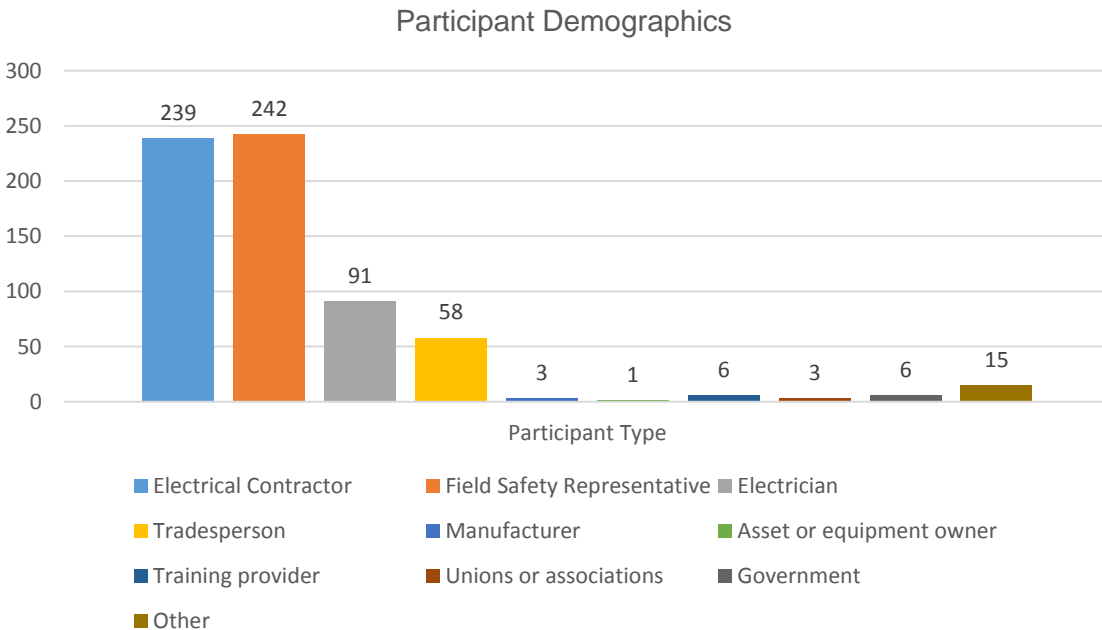

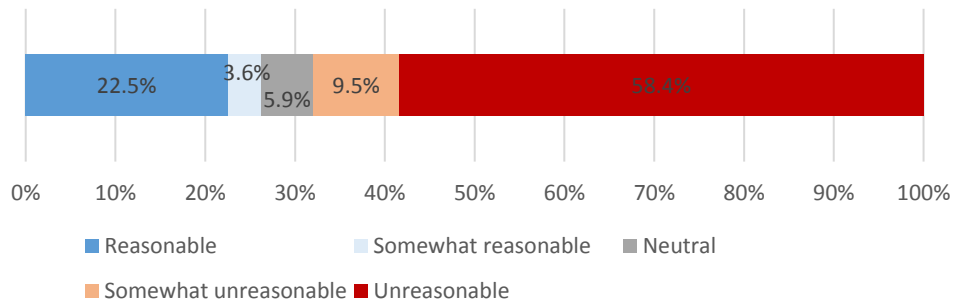
## PARTICIPANT DEMOGRAPHICS

The majority of respondents were electrical contractors (35%), field safety representatives (33%), or electricians (12%), out of a total of 577 people who provided a response to this question.

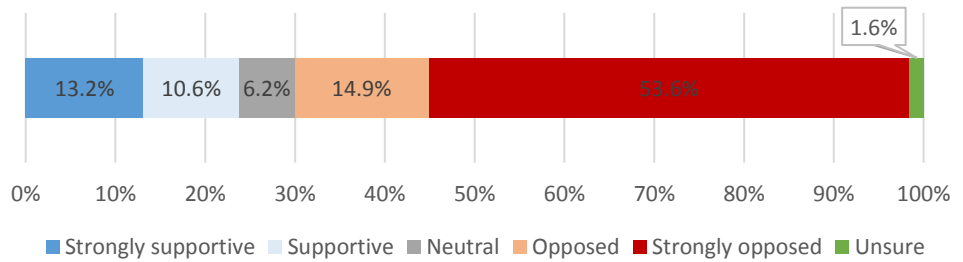


## FEEDBACK RECEIVED
